By the time you read this, the winning bidder for the management of the Ormond Beachside Tennis Center (OBTC) will (almost) have been picked. The City has convened a meeting for Tuesday, October 03. Out of the 17 parties which had downloaded the package, only 3 dared to make an offer: coach Trishna Patel, a new female tennis pro out of Palm Coast, and the Trails

Racquet Club. The evaluation is public and will take place at 10 am at City Hall. IF Trails wins the bid again, you will receive an instant e-mail update. If Trails doesn't win, the news will come later in some form. Or you can talk to Jan at the front desk any day after 10/03, of course. Either way, the new contract for the winner will start December 01 and run for 3 years.
